| 1 | Luke 1:4 | That you may know the certainty of those things in which you were instructed. |
| 2 | Luke 1:31 | And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and call His name JESUS. |
| 3 | Luke 1:32 | He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. |
| 4 | Luke 1:37 | For with God nothing will be impossible. |
| 5-6 | Luke 1:46-47 | (46)And Mary said, "My soul magnifies the Lord, (47) And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior." |
| 7 | Luke 2:7 | And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn. |
| 8 | Luke 2:11 | For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. |
| 9 | Luke 2:14 | Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, goodwill toward men! |

- 10 Luke 2:52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.
- 11 Luke 3:16 John answered, saying to all, "I indeed baptize you with water; but One mightier than I is coming, whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."
- 12 Luke 4:4 But Jesus answered him, saying, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.'"
- 13 Luke 4:8 And Jesus answered and said to him, "Get behind me, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.'"
- 14 Luke 4:12 And Jesus answered and said to him, "It has been said, 'You shall not tempt the Lord your God.'"
- 15 Luke 4:24 Then He said, "Assuredly, I say to you, no prophet is accepted in his own country."
- 16 Luke 4:32 And they were astonished at His teaching, for His word was with authority.
- 17 Luke 5:11 So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him.
- 18 Luke 5:16 So He Himself often withdrew into the wilderness and prayed.
- 19 Luke 5:32 I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance.
- 20-22 Luke 6:14-16 (14) Simon, whom He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; James and John; Philip and Bartholomew; (15) Matthew and Thomas; James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon called the Zealot; (16) Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot who also became a traitor.
- 23 Luke 6:22 Blessed are you when men hate you, and when they exclude you, and revile you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of Man's sake.
- 24-25 Luke 6:27-28 (27)But I say to you who hear: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, (28) bless those who curse you, and pray for those who spitefully use you."

- 26 Luke 7:9 When Jesus heard these things, He marveled at him, and turned around and said to the crowd that followed Him, "I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!"
- 27 Luke 8:11 Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.
- 28 Luke 8:15 But the ones that fell on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience.
- 29 Luke 8:25 But He said to the, "Where is your faith?" And they were afraid, and marveled, saying to one another, "Who can this be? For He commands even the winds and water, and they obey Him!"
- 30 Luke 9:16 Then He took the five loaves and the two fish, and looking up to heaven, He blessed and broke them, and gave them to the disciples to set before the multitude.
- 31 Luke 9:17 So they all ate and were filled, and twelve baskets of the leftover fragments were taken up by them.
- 32 Luke 9:20 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered and said, "The Christ of God."
- 33 Luke 9:25 For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and is himself destroyed or lost?
- 34 Luke 9:35 And a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son. Hear Him!"
- 35 Luke 9:62 But Jesus said to him, "No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."
- 36 Luke 10:2 Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore, pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."
- 37 Luke 10:27 So he answered and said, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind,' and 'your neighbor as yourself.'"

- 38 Luke 10:37 And he said, "He who showed mercy on him." Then Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."
- 39-41 Luke 11:2-4 (2) So He said to them, "When you pray, say: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (3) Give us day by day our daily bread. (4) And forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one."
- 42 Luke 11:9 So I say to you, ask and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.
- 43 Luke 12:7 But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows.
- 44 Luke 12:15 And He said to them, "Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses."
- 45 Luke 12:31 But seek the kingdom of God, and all these things shall be added to you.
- 46 Luke 12:34 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
- 47 Luke 12:40 Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour that you do not expect.
- 48 Luke 13:3 I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish.
- 49 Luke 13:5 I tell you, no; but unless you repent you will all likewise perish.
- 50 Luke 13:19 It is like a mustard seed, which a man took and put in his garden; and it grew and became a large tree, and the birds of the air nested in its branches.
- 51 Luke 13:24 Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I say to you, will seek to enter and will not be able.
- 52 Luke 14:11 For whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

- 53 Luke 14:27 And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple.
- 54 Luke 15:7 I say to you that likewise there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine just persons who need no repentance.
- 55 Luke 15:20 And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him.
- 56 Luke 15:24 For this may son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found. And they began to be merry.
- 57 Luke 16:13 No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.
- 58 Luke 17:3 Take heed to yourselves. If your brother sins against you, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him.
- 59 Luke 17:32 Remember Lot's wife.
- 60 Luke 18:7 And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them?
- 61 Luke 18:16 But Jesus called them to Him and said, "Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of God."
- 62 Luke 18:27 But He said "The things which are impossible with men are possible with God."
- 63 Luke 19:10 For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.
- 64 Luke 19:38 Saying, "Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- 65 Luke 19:46 Saying to them, "It is written, 'My house is a house of prayer,' but you have made it a den of thieves."

- 66 Luke 20:17 Then He looked at them and said, “What then is this that was written: ‘The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone’?”
- 67 Luke 20:25 And He said to them, “Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s and to God the things that are God’s.”
- 68 Luke 20:38 For He is not the God of the dead but of the living, for all live to Him.
- 69 Luke 21:33 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away.
- 70 Luke 22:19 And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, “This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.”
- 71 Luke 22:20 Likewise He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.”
- 72 Luke 22:26 But not so among you; on the contrary, he who is greatest among you, let him be as the younger, and he who governs as he who serves.
- 73 Luke 22:42 Saying, “Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done.”
- 74 Luke 22:44 And being in agony, He prayed more earnestly. Then His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground.
- 75 Luke 22:63 Now the men who held Jesus mocked Him and beat Him.
- 76 Luke 22:70 Then they all said, “Are You then the Son of God?” So He said, to them, “You rightly say that I am.”
- 77 Luke 23:3 Then Pilate asked Him, saying, “Are you the King of the Jews?” He answered him and said, “It is as you say.”
- 78 Luke 23:11 Then Herod, with his men of war, treated Him with contempt and mocked Him, arrayed Him in a gorgeous robe, and sent Him back to Pilate.

- 79-80 Luke 23:20-21 (20) Pilate, therefore, wishing to release Jesus, again called out to them. (21) But they shouted, saying, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!"
- 81 Luke 23:26 Now as they led Him away, they laid hold of a certain man, Simon a Cyrenian, who was coming from the country, and on him they laid the cross that he might bear it after Jesus.
- 82 Luke 23:33 And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one of the right hand and the other on the left.
- 83 Luke 23:34 Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots.
- 84 Luke 23:38 And an inscription also was written over Him in letters of Greek, Latin, and Hebrew: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS.
- 85-86 Luke 23:42-43 (42) Then he said to Jesus, "Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom." (43) And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise."
- 87-88 Luke 23:44-45 (44) Now it was about the sixth hour, and there was darkness over all the earth until the ninth hour. (45) Then the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn in two.
- 89 Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, "Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit." Having said this, He breathed His last.
- 90 Luke 23:47 So when the centurion saw what had happened, he glorified God, saying, "Certainly this was a righteous Man!"
- 91 Luke 23:53 Then he took it down, wrapped it in linen, and laid it in a tomb that was hewn out of the rock, where no one had ever lain before.
- 92 Luke 24:1 Now on the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they and certain other women with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared.
- 93-94 Luke 24:2-3 (2) But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb. (3) Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.

- 95 Luke 24:6 He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee.
- 96 Luke 24:12 But Peter arose and ran to the tomb; and stooping down, he saw the linen cloths lying by themselves; and he departed, marveling to himself at what had happened.
- 97 Luke 24:32 And they said to one another, “Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?”
- 98 Luke 24:39 Behold My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself. Handle Me and see, for a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see I have.
- 99-100 Luke 24:46-47 (46) Then He said to them, “Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, (47) and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.”
